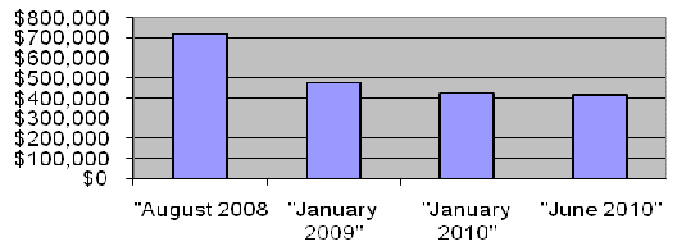
The deadline for material for the August 8/15 edition of the bulletin is Wednesday, July 28.
